The Center is in the rural hills northwest of New York's Greenwood Lake area, just 50 miles northwest of New York City.

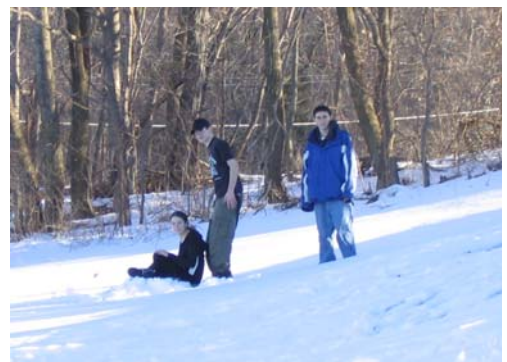


- 465 beautiful acres with 7 miles of hiking trails
