WORK SCHOLARSHIPS

These scholarships reduce the camper fee by \$150. Work Scholarships entail approximately 90 minutes of work every day, as dishwasher helper.

Non-Work SCHOLARSHIPS

Non-Work Scholarships are available as well. Some are simply need based and some are for potential or practicing teachers, leaders, singers and musicians. This aid is usually in addition to a work scholarship. If you are interested in applying for a non-work scholarship, answer all the questions on the Scholarship Application Form,

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Please note that camp applications must include a deposit to hold a space while scholarship applications are being considered. A full refund will be given if you must cancel due to insufficient scholarship aid.

To apply for a scholarship, fill out the Scholarship Application Form, <http://www.tradmadcamp.org/scholarship-application.pdf>, and return it to TradMad Camp with your registration and deposit. Applications received by March 31, the registration processing and lottery date, will be processed first, and those applicants will be notified of their registration and scholarship status in early April. All funds may be assigned at that time, but later applications for scholarships will be considered if funds are still or become available.
